## Crime Watch Information

Hello Everyone:

As nice weather arrives the Fishers Police Department is asking everyone to watch for any suspicious activity. The arrival of the warm weather attracts families to our Town Parks and other public places. Please remember to lock your vehicles when you leave them.
